- A Pronounced similar to 'a' of father.
E Pronounced similar to 'e' of end
I Pronounced similar to 'i' of in
O Pronounced similar to 'o' of or
U Pronounced similar to 'oo' of cool
- C Spain – an English *th sound* (three) before **e** or **i**.
Latin America - *s sound* before **e** or **i**.
a *k sound* before other vowels.
- H Silent
- J English *h*.
- G Before **e** or **i** has the same sound as a Spanish **J**.
- LL Similar to an English *y*.
- Ñ English *ni/ ny*
- R At the beginning of the word or **after l, n, s** and the **RR** are trilled.
- V Spanish **B**.
- Z In Spain – it is pronounced the same as the combinations **ce** or **ci**.
In Latin America – it is pronounced as an **S**.
